Pre-Festival Performances at San Marcos High School

These evening pre-festivals are an opportunity for our musicians to show off their hard work in a supportive environment and respond to any feedback prior to taking their pieces to the competition festivals. The choir will be our first group of musicians to kick things off at San Marcos High School where judges, hired by the district's music programs, will review each piece and recommend improvements. El Camino Band Festival - Golden Eagle Band

Our very own Golden Eagle Band will be the first to kick off competition season at the Southern California School Band and Orchestra Association festival hosted by El Camino High School. Our musicians will be adjudicated on three prepared pieces of music and sight-read for a rating. This type of event is part of the state and national standards for music education and gives students the experience of putting their music knowledge to the test outside of the regular school day.

Cal State Fullerton Music Festival - Wind Symphony

A two day Band Festival in which students will perform 3 prepared pieces for college music professors. After the performance, students attend a clinic led by one of the professors in a full band setting. The day is filled with high level performances which the students have the chance to hear college level bands play. Our Wind Symphony is one of only two middle school groups that attend the festival comprised of mostly high school bands. It is a great chance to immerse our students in a day of music at the highest level.
